New Cigars at Nicks...

Nub by Oliva:

Oliva Cigar Co. and a former company sales rep Sam Leccia have introduced a cigar innovation that is creating tremendous buzz. The idea for the nubs came from the theory that a cigar finds its "sweet spot" at the 3 1/2- 4 inch point. All "nub" cigars must exist within this window. No "nub" is longer than 4 inches. Further adding to this complex theory, the ring gauges range from 56-66. The result is a range of smokes that have the same amount of tobacco as any Churchill or even Presidente. Unbelievably, they also smoke as long. The cigar comes in three wrappers: Habano, Cameroon, and Connecticut. There are three sizes shared by all wrappers plus an additional size which is unique to each wrapper. The flavor range is from mild to full but always complex and hearty.



A. Pontillo 1776:

AJ Pontillo has created a new line of cigars using only 100% American grown tobacco. It comes from Connecticut, Massachusetts, Pennsylvania & North Carolina. The Wrapper is one of the highest-grade Connecticut wrappers and can fool you into thinking it is a light to medium bodied cigar. It is a complete full-bodied cigar. This cigar is extremely limited and you may not have heard of it yet, but you will. It is available in 4 different sizes and a 21-count box (Minuteman is 28).

Minuteman 3 1/2 x 45

Perfecto 4 3/4 x 54

Robusto Grande 5 1/2 x 54

Double Corona 7 1/2 x 50

J. Fuego:

Jesus Fuego has ventured on his own following in his families footsteps of great cigar making for 5 generations. The Corojo blend utilizes a sun grown Corojo wrapper which is proprietary to this blend. The Corojo blend is medium to full bodied with a velvet smooth finish. The J. Fuego "Natural" blend features a shade grown "Criollo" wrapper and produces a sweet medium bodied smoke with a hint of pepper and spice on the finish.
